

Steps to Obtain Your MAT Waiver



Check Your Eligibility

To apply for a waiver you must have a valid medical license and an active DEA number. Apply for a DEA number with Drug Enforcement Agency's Diversion Control Division (Registration Support) here.

Take 24 hours of required coursework

PCSS-MAT offers for FREE the required 24 hours of medication assisted treatment (MAT) waiver training with continuing education from AAPA (8 hour MAT and 16 hour course).

- 8 hour course
- 16 hour course





Complete your Notice of Intent Form

Once you have finished the 24 hours of training, complete the NOI form <u>online</u> and submit it to the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA) for review.

Forward your Certificates of Completion to SAMHSA

When you complete the 8-hour waiver training and 16-hour training, PCSS-MAT will send you via email your certificates of completion for each. Fax the certificates to 301 576-5237 or email it to SAMHSA.



Once SAMHSA has obtained all documentation, the process requires approximately 45 days.

This program has been reviewed and is approved for a maximum of 16.00 AAPA Category 1 CME credits by the AAPA Review Panel. Approval is valid for one year from the issue date of 02/15/2017. Participants may submit the post-test at any time during that period.
